On 25 June, UUCO was fortunate to hear a presentation by Sylvia Coleman, Executive Director of the Owensboro Human Relations Commission. In our 11th annual Denounce Torture program, Ms. Coleman began by reading Niemoeller's poem from WWII, "First they came for the Socialists..." With this text and examples from Owensboro today, she illustrated that our common humanity demands we be concerned for each other and working for each other's good or we all suffer. Ms. Coleman also urged us to cultivate compassion within ourselves that we might be prepared for compassion with and service to others.
