

## A SPECIAL WORD ABOUT OUR MOVIE & CONCERT

We are very excited to have both a Movie opportunity and a Celebration Concert this year!

- The Movie at the Malco is on Thursday, 9 Nov @ 7:30 pm. It is about the life and work of beloved Zen Buddhist, Thich Nhat Hanh. It is narrated by Benedict Cumberbatch. (Trailer available at <a href="http://walkwithmefilm.com">http://walkwithmefilm.com</a>) It is the first time that Faith Fest has tried this arrangement; it is part of a program called Theatrical on Demand that brings documentaries to the big screen. Reservations need to be made by 28 October in order for the film to be shown. The cost of a ticket is \$12.50 and must be reserved online at <a href="http://gathr.us/screening/20711">http://gathr.us/screening/20711</a>. Unfortunately, I don't have any negotiating room on this one. If you are able to buy a seat or two for someone in your organization that can't afford it that would be terrific, but you'll have to do it directly through the website and enter your guest's name on the reservation. If we don't sell enough seats, your card won't be charged—and you will be notified by email that the movie is off.
- Owensboro favorites, Heath and Molly will be appearing at 1UU on Saturday, 11 Nov @ 7 pm. Heath and Molly have a positive message about learning to accept people in their difference and looking for the best in life. The reason there is a charge for this is very simple: We are paying the artists. They have been very generous in agreeing to a ticket price of \$12 in advance and \$15 at the door. A separate poster with details is attached. If you have someone in financial need that wants to attend, please contact me about the circumstances. I have very limited resources to negotiate a special ticket—but I want to do that if at all possible. Likewise, if you have someone that would like to donate a ticket or two, that would expand our ability to include our less affluent neighbors. (Reservations should be made through me and checks should be made out to UUCO.)

These are the only Faith Fest events for which there is a charge. Even with these, we want to make them as accessible as possible and with your help that will happen.
