

*Greetings,*

*The Board met on Sunday, May 17, 2020, to discuss resuming in-person Sunday church services. The Board took into consideration several factors, including recommendations in a letter from UUA President Susan Frederick-Gray, the number of Covid-19 cases in Kentucky and Daviess County, the small size of our congregation, and our willingness to strictly adhere to social distancing and safety standards.*

*We will start in-person church services effective Sunday, June 14, 2020.*

*At this time we will hold in-person services on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of each month. The 14-day period between services is the standard quarantine time for Covid-19 and will give congregants time to self-monitor their health.*

*We will monitor the state levels of infection. If a spike occurs, in-person services will likely be canceled. If infection rates decline at a steady pace, in-person services may be conducted weekly.*
